Title: Everything New Community Members Need to Know About Local Government

Level: High School

Overview: Using the information the students gathered from their online scavenger hunt, they will create a detailed pamphlet to inform the public about their local government.

Length: 1-2 days

Standard: 4.3 Analyze how public policy- domestic and foreign- is developed at the local, state, and national levels and compare how policy-making occurs in other forms of government.

Evidence outcome: Analyze and discuss multiple perspectives on state issues and option for participating in civic affairs by shaping policies.

Activities

- 1. Warm-up: Ask students, "What surprised you from your scavenger hunt yesterday? Explain.
- 2. Students will use the information they gathered from their online hunt to create a brochure. They can work individually or in a pair. The purpose of the brochure is to inform local citizens about their government. See attached document #8

What Do New Residents Need to Know About Local Government?

You have been hired to create a "Welcome to Our Area" brochure detailing what new residents need to know about local government in your area. Work with a group of 2 or 3 other students to collect, organize and publish an informative brochure, poster, Powerpoint or web site.

Each brochure must include the following items:

- 1. A list of the 10 ten terms people should know about local government
- 2. An overview of your county government, city government, and school districts and at least one special district
- 3. For each type provide the following information:
 - a. Leaders
 - b. Departments and Services Provided
 - c. Budget Information
 - d. Key Issues
- 4. At least three visuals pictures, maps, graphs, charts, etc.
- 5. Links to web resources
